In Honor of Alexis



Alexis was a beloved student at DanceEmpower whose kindness, humor, and bright spirit touched everyone around her. She made friends effortlessly and loved being part of the studio, dancing with company three nights each week. Her smile, determination, and love for dance brought joy to so many.

During summer classes, we noticed Alexis was not herself. She seemed unusually clumsy, running into walls and struggling with things that normally came easily to her. Deeply concerned, we called her mother and encouraged her to take Alexis to urgent care immediately. That moment became the beginning of an unimaginable journey.

Alexis was diagnosed with DIPG, a rare and aggressive terminal brain tumor. She bravely endured six weeks of radiation treatment and participated in the ONC201 clinical trial. When an MRI later revealed that the tumor had metastasized, she was withdrawn from the trial. Despite every challenge she faced, Alexis continued to fight with courage and grace. She underwent an additional 20 rounds of radiation, giving her a few more precious months to create memories with the people she loved most.

Alexis courageously battled DIPG for one full year, from July 16, 2019, to July 16, 2020. Her strength, resilience, and beautiful spirit continue to inspire the DanceEmpower family every day. She will always be remembered and deeply missed.

In Alexis's honor, our studio proudly donates each year to The Cure Starts Now, where 100% of donations go toward research dedicated to finding a cure for pediatric brain cancer and helping eliminate this devastating disease.
